A07 - Jackfield - WMRC Student Modellers

B05 - Bouilliere - Tom de Decker - O - Belgium

This layout represents a depot in the region of the Ardennes, where there is a lot of wood traffic. It will be coming all the way from Belgium so the Warley NEC show is very probably the only chance to see it in the UK.

B07 - Bregenbach im Schwarzwald - Bingham MRC N Gauge Group - N - Germany

Bregenbach is a new layout by club member Les Richardson, started as a lockdown project.

It represents a small wayside industry on a fictional cross-country line in the Black Forest in Germany. The Bregtalbahn in reality ran from Donaueschingen on the Schwarzwaldbahn to the small town of Furtwangen and closed in the 1970s.

The fiction sees it extended over the pass and down the Glottertal to Freiburg im Breisgau and electrified while still remaining a private railway. It stays open by having lower track access charges than the DB thus being attractive as a route for short trains. The line has a ruling gradient of 1 in 25, which is actually LESS steep than the DB line in the neighbouring valley. Trains ascend to Bregenbach station in both directions, with occasional passenger services calling and very occasionally two trains crossing here, though the through freights are too long for the loop.

Sometimes the brewery shunter will venture off down the hill to the exchange point at Furtwangen to collect or deliver vans. Most trains have an electric loco on the front, or occasionally on the back....

B09 - Williamson River - Cupar & District MRC - 1:87 - HO - Canada

The layout represents a small industrial line, somewhere in British Columbia, Canada. Featuring a small terminus station where Budd Rail Cars take passengers to work. The line has mixed freight services from both Canadian National (CN) and Canadian Pacific (CP). A small fuel terminal receives fuel tankers thanks to its track access. Cut Lumber is delivered to the Timber yard by truck and departs in mixed freight cars. The larger industrial building receives and dispatches multiple box cars.

B10 - Tuerland - Duncan Malcolm - German Trams

B12 - Obertonberg - John Coulston - N - Germany

B14 - Beijiao - Paul Stapleton - 1:87 - HO - Industrial China in the 21st Century

The last days of mainline steam in China.

B17 - Solent Summit - Bob Norris - N - USA

This large 'N' gauge layout was built by members of the Gosport American Model Railway Club. It has passing loops, a station, industrial sidings, coal mine, power station, tunnel, steel viaduct, chemical plant, switching yards and countryside including canyons and desert.

B18 - A Taste of Alber - Dave Paylor - 1:120 - TTe - Czech

Czech Narrow Gauge. A TTe layout based in the south of the Czech Republic.

"A Taste of Alber" is a model of a station on the 760mm line in the south of the Czech Republic centred at Jindřichův Hradec. The real line still exists, run by a private company (the JHMD) who "bought" the line for 1 Czech Crown from the State! They still run a full passenger service and also steam hauled Tourist trains and some goods trains.

B20 - Klützig (and 4 micro layouts) - Hans Louvet - 1:87 - HO - Germany

The idyllic resort of Klützig is a beautiful modular layout (H0 scale) built by Hans Louvet. This layout shows model railway in small spaces can be very romantic and beautiful. Watching it, we imagine ourselves being in northern Germany at the time of the Deutsche Reichsbahn.

B23 - Salzgrabe - River MRC - 1:87 - HOe - Austria

An Austrian salt mine

B24 - Blindheim - Bill Bishop - O - Germany

A model of a branch line terminus set in Upper Franconia, operating both steam locos and diesels.

B26 - Karolina Falls - David Bailey - On30 - USA

Small American circular railway with real waterfall

American steam/early diesel

B27 - Eight Dollar Canyon - Graham Broad - 1:87 - HO - USA

An octagonal layout viewable from all eight sides!

B30 - Dawlish Warren - Chris Morris - 1:148 - N - Steam

A model of Dawlish Warren in Devon. For this outing it will be running loco classes 50, 37,33, 47 and 31. There weill also be a 158 and a Skipper unit.

B31 - Monument Lane - Ted Robinson - 1:148 - N - Steam

A model of Monument Lane station in Birmingham.

B32 - Wartson Hall - David Griffin - 1:148 - N - Steam

B33 - Cucknoe - Jon Boot - 1:148 - N - Steam

Fictitious cross-country route in Northants, circa 1956-62, representing many similar routes. Ex-LMS, LNER and BR Standard stock running continuously.

B35 - Copenhagen Fields - The Model Railway Club - 1:152 - N - Steam

Copenhagen Fields is a 2mm finescale model of the approach to Kings Cross in North London, set in the inter-war years. The layout is named after the park above the tunnel and is as accurate as possible given the necessary constraints of space.

B36 - Freshwater - Ian Morgan - 1:152 - N - Steam

Western terminus of the Isle of Wight lines set during the last years of operation, the post war years and the turmoil of nationalisation.

B37 - Hawes Junction - Warley MRC - 1:148 - N - Steam

Hawes Junction on the Settle & Carlisle as it was in the 1950s and early 1960s. The real station was renamed Garsdale after the Branch to Hawes closed.

B39 - Exe Halt - Steve Searson - 1:148 - N - Steam

Exe Halt is based upon a real location near Exeter actually called Up Exe but greatly compressed.

B40 - Moors View - Paul Holwill - 1:148 - N - Steam

Moors View is an additional station situated along the Ex-LSWR mainline between Exeter & Plymouth on the North Western edge of Dartmoor.

Set in deepest winter, Devon has been hit hard & with the sea wall at Dawlish being breached, making it impassible & Dartmoor being effected by heavy snow, the crews have their work cut out to keep the line open.

B41 - West Wick - Ian Monks - 1:148 - N - Steam

B42 - Kinlochlaggen - Michael Le Marie - 1:148 - N

Kinlochlaggen is based on a rural station somewhere in Scotland. The station has a passing loop and limited freight facilities. Trains frequently pass here, and the layout can be operated in the steam/green diesel era, the BR Blue era, Scotrail era or as a preserved line.

B43 - Crossharbour D4/5 - 1:148 - N - Wartime

A wartime harbour layout.

B45 - The Viaduct - Mike Plowman - 1:148 - N - Steam

A lockdown project representing current practice on the WCML.

B46 - Barnwood - Andrew Fardell - 1:148 - N - Steam

Barnwood is an N gauge layout set in the early 1990's in a fictional location in northwest England on a loop line off the West Coast Mainline between Preston and Lancaster. The town is busy with passing freight as it acts as a second route between Preston and Lancaster relieving pressure on this two track section of West Coast Mainline. Passenger services are worked by Regional Railways trains running to and from Preston and Barrow in Furness. There is a short branch line to Glasson on the estuary of the River Lune. The port features a container terminal, a grain terminal and a steel terminal. Other freight terminals in the town are an oil terminal, cement terminal, a large warehouse, a siding for the transhipment of logs and a Royal Mail terminal. Along side the station is a small loco depot.

C31 - Water Street Sidings - Gauge O Guild - 1:43.5 - O

A compact goods yard set in pre-grouping North Eastern days.

C32 - Weatherbury Magna and Monksbury - Ian White - 1:43.5 - O - GWR & LSWR - Steam

Based upon the station of Weatherbury Magna, which is shared by the GWR and LSWR, it offers a 360 degree viewing, with a continuous run for the GWR. The LSWR line crosses the GWR on the flat at Weatherbury Magna and follows the GWR until branching of at the River Piddle to a small coastal terminus at Monksbury.

C33 - Netherwood Sidings - Graham Clark - 1:43.5 - O

This layout represents the Woodhead line in its final years. The layout is based on a set of exchange sidings near

Sheffield. The track plan is freelance but based on features taken from Rotherwood and Wath. The bridges, in particular, are based on the real ones in the Rotherwood-Orgreaves area.

C34 - Edington Junction - East Kent O Gauge Group - 1:43.5 - O - S&D to BR

On the Somerset & Dorset Joint Railway's line between Burnham-on-Sea and Evercreech Junction, Edington Junction station was the junction for the seven mile branch to Bridgwater.

Edington was originally named Edington Road until the 21st July 1890, when the Bridgwater line was completed. On closure of this line, to passengers in December 1952 and goods in October 1954, the station was again renamed, this time to Edington Burtle. In February 1956 the track layout was rationalised and the signal box closed.

In the early days a great deal of goods traffic passed through here, to and from the jetty at Burnham-on-Sea and later the wharves at Highbridge. The traffic included coal (both ways, to & from Wales), rails, timber etc. and from Bridgwater bricks, tiles, lime and cement. Milk traffic between Bason Bridge and London continued until the end.

C35 - Hookton Riverside - Mike Bragg - 1:43.5 - O-16.5 - Steam

Hookton Riverside is the terminus station of the Hookton and Lipp Vale Railway, a narrow gauge railway in Dorset. The name Hookton and the almost river Lipp were taken from the novel Harlequin by Bernard Cornwall who kindly gave me permission to use them. As per usual I have created an alternate history by using the characters from Treasure Island by Robert Louis Stevenson but now set in the late 1940s early 1950s. The Pub/Inn is the Admiral Benbow, the large Georgian house is aptly named Trelawney House, there is Benjamin Gunns cheese shop, L.J. Silver & Son the friendly butchers, not forgetting B. Pew Hardware I had thought he might have traded as an optician. Doctor Livesey, Captain Smollett and several others. I really do need to get out more, although railway modelling has to be fun, with for me, the back story being just as important as the modelling.

C37 - Ellerton Road - Warley MRC - 1:43.5 - Scaleseven - Steam

Ellerton Road is based on the old Midland Railway terminal station at Ilkeston Town, off the Erewash Valley line.

C38 - Staindrop - Chris Robertson - 1:43.5 - O - LNER 1928

Welcome to the south west Durham countryside circa 1928.

Staindrop is a large village between Darlington and Barnard Castle, but never rail served. This 'might have been' branch is an attempt to model the old Central Division of the North Eastern Railway but in post grouping LNER days.

However, the pre grouping character of the branch remains with an infrastructure of pure NER. The buildings and structures are all locally sourced. The station building is based on Battersby, the water tank from Middleton-in-Teesdale, and the wooden overbridge from the Stainmore line. Many of the details, such as fencing, are researched from original NER sources and drawings. The signal box, based on Bowes, and signals are pure Central Division - not slotted and have simple caps rather than finials. The viaduct is based on an NER timber trestle from Ushaw Moor which lasted until the 1960's.

C39 - Grange Lane - Steve Saxby Neepsend MRS - 1:43.5 - O - Diesel/Electric

C40 - Barrow Street - John Smerdon - 1:43.5 - O - BR - Diesel/Electric

C41 - Hillport Goods - Steve Farmer - 1:43.5 - O - BR Diesel

The layout is set in North Staffordshire in the period of the late 70s and represents a small urban yard of the type that was soon to disappear. The yard handles mainly commodities and sundries traffic in vans and open wagons which are bought in on trip workings.

Also to be seen is domestic coal traffic along with tanks of heating oil to the Knype fuels siding. Traffic to Midland steel and Albion cement terminal also come into the yard to run round or drop wagons off to be shunted out.

Trackwork is by PECO and control is analogue with a hand held controller to allow movement up and down the layout. Buildings are from the Skytrex range or are scratchbuilt with greenery from Woodland Scenics and Greenscene.

Locos are RTR from Heljan and Dapol with rolling stock from various manufacturers of kits in O gauge along with a few RTR wagons.

C43 - Awdry St Nicholas - 1:76 - OO - Fictional

A "drive it yourself" layout aimed at younger modellers, based on the writings of Rev W Awdrey.

C50 - Ballyconnell Road - Stephen Moor - 1:101.6 - 15.75mm - Ireland

Around 1866 the Irish North Western Railway Company nearly extended the already completed Bundoran line into the important town and port which is Sligo. minerals known as bayrites had been found locally and the route neatly filled a gap in the railway map of Ireland.

It formed a far flung outpost of the Great Northern Railway of Ireland since that company's formation in 1876 by merger of the INWR with other local railways. Now it is 1955 and a few tourists and remnants of the mining industry are barely justifying the continued operation of this otherwise local route.

All this in 3mm/1ft (1:101.6) scale on 15.75mm gauge to portray the Irish broad gauge of 5 ft 3in. Even though the track gauge may look similar it is not OO!

C51 - Portsea - Paul Hopkins - 1:101.6 - TT

An evocative pastiche of Portsmouth's railways.

C63 - Binns Road - H.R.C.A - 1:76 - OO - Classic Hornby Dublo

The trains we remember from our childhood (or our dad remembered from his!).

D12 - Passage Lane TMD - Robert Potter and Charlotte Saunderson - 1:76 - OO - Diesel/Electric

Passage Lane TMD is a fictitious layout based on modern day diesel depots.

D16 - Readham - Steve Cox - 1:76 - OO - Diesel/Electric

Readham the model layout has been inspired by a combination of the conurbations of Reading and Cheltenham.

Buildings are scratch built, there is a traditional Regency inspired residential and shopping area, plus a modern retail park. The station complex includes a full station with four platforms. A modern Bombardier Flexity 2 tram can be seen running through the streets and shopping areas.

Other scenic highlight features include a Showman's winter quarters with working drop tower ride and transport park with pulled down rides.

Trains are modern image and DCC controlled and include sound.

D19 - Newhaven Harbour - Mike Turner Wigan and Wirral Finescale Group - 1:76 - OO - Diesel/Electric

Newhaven Harbour is based on the infrastructure of the Newhaven and Seaford Branch in East Sussex and is intended to provide a flavour of the general location.

It reflects operations on the BR Southern Region between 1968 and 1974 at which time, Newhaven was served by 27 miles of track and three stations - Harbour, Marine and Town. Passenger traffic was handled by a variety of Electric Multiple Units (EMUs) – 2-HAL, 2-BIL, 4-VEP, 4-CEP were common while it even saw 5-BEL 'Brighton Belle' Pullman sets on special workings. Goods traffic was predominantly bananas transported in their distinctive 'yellow-spot' vans. During this period the engineering department was busy filling in several tidal pools to the east of Marine station with sidings laid on the beach, and all manner of dropside open wagons were pressed in to service for the work. For interest, we have also added a mineral wagon flow serving a coal-fired power station. Operation reflects the patterns of traffic of this period with wagons arriving in holding sidings before being shunted off to their destination on the East Wharf branch.

D20 - Entering The Yard - Shaun Holland - 1:76 - OO - Diesel/Electric

Entering the Yard is a fictional, modern, micro, 00 gauge D.C.C layout.

The appearance is that of a small privately owned scrapyard filled with plenty of detail to look at.

There is a list of things to spot and other little details to see to keep viewers eyes interested.

D22 - South Pelaw - John Donnelly - 1:76 - EM - Steam

A model of South Pelaw Junction on the Tyne Dock to Consett line as it was in the late 1950s/early 1960s.

D23 - Ravenscroft Sidings - Terry Bendall - 1:76 - S4/P4 - BR Sectorisation

Ravenscroft Sidings is a fictitious layout set in the industrial heart of Teesside. Taking its inspiration from the heavy industries found in the area, the layout features a rail-served steel distribution terminal with overhead gantry crane. Other passing freight traffic also features whilst the line still supports a spartan passenger service in the form of DMUs.

Set during 1988, the layout depicts the early period of Sectorisation as Railfreight adopted the sub-sector structure and associated triple-grey livery, with freshly repainted locos rubbing shoulders with classmates still variously in BR blue, Railfreight grey and assorted other colours. With Thornaby being the local main depot, its fleet of Kingfisher emblem-shod diesels is much in evidence, working a variety of trip, mixed and bulk freights.

D52 - Loft City Central - Brendan Baker - Vintage Playmobil

A fun slice of childhood memories.

E09 - Yewston Road MPD - David and Alison Barker - 1:76 - OO - Steam

Yewston Road is a former LNWR motive power depot somewhere in the north-west of England. Based on the cramped track layout of the depot at Lancaster Green Ayre, it is set around 1960. There is a four-road engine shed in the later LMS style with a reinforced concrete roof and smoke vents, accessed via the 70-foot turntable. The coal stage is a typical LNWR "coal hole" and there is a fuel point for the new-fangled diesels in one corner.

E10 - Rolvenden - Robin Gay - 1:76 - S4/P4 - Steam

Rolvenden is a Colonel Stephens light railway. It is modelled in P4 and it represents the station of that name on the Kent & East Sussex Railway in the mid 1920's. Using plans, drawings and photos I have done my best to accurately represent the site within the constraints of the space available. Outside of the station limits I have used modellers licence to bring some typical Kentish scenes, such as an Oast House, a hop garden and a windmill to the layout.

E11 - Shillingsford - Ron Randall - 1:76 - OO - Steam

Shillingsford is a fictional branch station, loosely based on Shillingstone on the Somerset and Dorset Railway, set in the early sixties, but as a terminus rather than a through station.

The layout is DCC controlled using a Digitrax radio controlled system, and all of the locos are DCC sound fitted. Most have firebox glow and working lights.

The layout consists of a three platform station and a goods yard that contains a fairly large cattle dock.

The layout is kept very busy with passenger trains, goods trains, and various shunting movements. There is rarely a moment when something isn't moving!

All rolling stock is fitted with Kadee couplings, giving a very pleasing operating and viewing experience.

The fiddle yard is a double rotating sector plate that allows locomotives to be uncoupled and run around trains.

E12 - Rosebury Goods - Neil Woodbine - 1:76 - OO - Diesel/Electric

Rosebury Goods represents a 1980s freight scene in the Black Country. Featured in Hornby magazine in April 2022.

E46 - Star Lane - Mike Peace - 1:76 - OO - Southern 3rd Rail Electrics - 1960s

A representation of Hooley, between Coulsden and Redhill.

E48 - Hewisbridge - Ian Porteous - 1:76 - OO - Steam

Hewisbridge is a small market town somewhere in the Scottish Borders in the late 1950s, and is intended to represent the railways which were once commonplace in the Scottish Borders and much inspiration has been drawn from the Waverley route as most of the structures are based on those from various locations on that famous line.

E50 - Nictun 2000 - Elliott Cowton Fareham MRC - 1:76 - OO - Diesel/Electric

As co-builder of Nictun Borrud, I liked it so much I thought I would replicate it and bring it into the 21st century based on it surviving the Dr Beeching cuts and prospering to day (and to run my modern stock). The goods yard has gone, replaced by a car sales and petrol station and the old World War II military sidings developed to house a wagon maintenance facility. The Sub Power Station has also been upgraded.

E51 - Nictun Borrud - Elliott Cowton Fareham MRC - 1:76 - OO - Steam

Nictun Borrud is set somewhere in the rolling chalk downland of the Southern Hampshire. It represents the terminus of a small branch line with some freight facility and is set in the late steam/early diesel period. The layout is built to finescale OO standards and features kit built Southern Region 3rd Rail Electric units.

E52 - Garreg Wen - Matt Kean - 1:76 - OO9 - Steam

The model is set in Snowdonia in the Victorian period (approximately 1880) and represents the modest upper terminus for passenger working of a former horse tramway, converted to steam a few years previously. The quarry extension leaves the back of the station to the foot of an incline located 'off set', but due to the gradient and the threat of runaway slate wagons, the passenger platform is on a separate line, as also happened at Bryngwyn on the NWNGR for example.

E53 - Kaninchenbau - Iain Morrison - 1:76 - HOe - Steam

Kaninchenbau is a computer controlled HOe layout, modelled on the rolling, grassy meadows that are typical of the European Alpine region. The hands-off aspect of automation allows discussions about the layout to be undertaken whilst the layout continues to run.

E54 - Bont - John Wooden - 1:76 - OO9 - Steam

E55 - Green End - David Gander - 1:76 - OO9 - Steam

The layout is based on the Welshpool & Llanfair Railway, including models of several W&L structures. It is a fine example of how you can build an OO9 layout in a small space, being intended originally to run across the top of a couple of bookcases. It was featured in 'Railway Modeller' in August 2004.

E56 - Mannin Middle - Peter Cullen - 1:76 - OO9 - Steam

Mannin Middle assumes that the Isle of Man Railway had extended the Foxdale branch to form a triangular junction at Ballasalla with the southern line from Douglas to Port Erin. This route was surveyed but never built.

The railway is portrayed either in the summer of 1964 or 1967 when holiday habits were changing and short passenger trains with few passengers were now the order of the day.

E58 - Clyre Valley Railway - Tim Couling - 1:76 - OO9

A large U-shaped layout set in North Cornwall.

E59 - Annascaul - Paul Titmuss - 1:76 - OO_{n3} - Steam

Annascaul is a village in County Kerry, south west Ireland, and is best known as the location where the last wild wolf was killed in Britain and Ireland (1786). It was also the birth place and home of the Antarctic explorer Tom Crean who accompanied Scott and Shackleton on their expeditions to the southern continent at the beginning of the twentieth century.

The layout is modelled in 4mm scale with 12mm gauge track (mostly PECO HOm) and this is known as 00n3. Stock is built from the wide range of kits available – in plastic, resin, white metal, card and brass – all based on 3' gauge prototypes from the railways of Ireland and the Isle of Man. Stand and watch and you should see a variety of trains from several 3' gauge lines passing by.

E60 - Castle Caerinion - Martyn Harrison - 1:76 - OO9

A narrow gauge layout set in Wales

E61 - Fort Whiting - Charlie Insley - 1:76 - OO9

The layout is set on the fictional island of New Gelderland, several hundred miles east of South Africa. Originally a Dutch colony, the island was taken by the British in the 19th century and served as an important naval base until after the Second World War. In the early 20th century, a 2'6" gauge railway was built to connect the main port and town on the island, Port Canning, to other smaller towns on the island, including the small military base at Fort Whiting. Locomotives were provided by a number of British builders, including Hunslet, Kitson, Nasmyth-Wilson, as well as American builders such as Baldwin. In reality, the layout was built to run a collection of colonial-style 009 stock, and is based on the Mid Illovo branch on the South African 2ft gauge lines in Natal.

E62 - Angst Lesspork - Hugh Norwood - 1:76 - OO9

Angst-Lesspork draws its inspiration from and is a tribute to the "Discworld" books of Terry Pratchett (describing a flat world travelling through space on the backs of four elephants which in turn stand on the back of a giant turtle...), and in particular the greatest city on the Circle Sea, Ankh-Morpork.

The scene For this 009 layout is urban with a tidal river to the front. Buildings are predominately timber-framed. Although superficially a Victorian / Edwardian townscape, many characters and architectural features give clues to the layout's true identity.

E63 - Devonmoor - Dartmoor 009 Group - 1:76 - OO9

A modular layout from the Dartmoor OO9 Group

E65 - Byway MPD - John Gay - 1:76 - OO

This compact 'OO' gauge depot layout is set on the Midland Region in the late 1950s/early 1960s. The setting is urban and it is not based on a particular prototype but it is distinctly steam era, with a Midland Region 1960s theme.

E67 - Long Melford Junction - Nigel Locke - 1:76 - OO - BR 1950s

Long Melford is a OO gauge Model Railway depicting the station of the same name on The Stour Valley Line in Suffolk, as it was in the late 1950's. Trains come and go from Sudbury at one end, and then to and from either Haverhill or Cambridge on the main line, or, via the junction to Bury St Edmunds on the branch.

There is a working signal box situated on the viewing side, with a replica signal box diagram on the back scene, so the public can see how signalling operations were carried out.

E68 - Cottley - Tom McKee North Downs MRS - 1:76 - OO - Steam

Cottley is a branch station with passenger, goods and cattle traffic. It is served by small tank and tender locomotives. The facilities are shared by both the WR and MR so a mix of locos can be seen.

E69 - Camel Quay - Terry Robinson - 1:76 - OO - North Cornwall - Steam

Camel Quay is a typical North Cornwall ex-LSWR station on the River Camel lying on the Rock-Delabole railway, had it been built. The station, with its goods shed, bears more than a resemblance to Padstow.

There are local passenger services with express trains from Waterloo. Southern National's buses link the high street and station with outlying towns and villages.

E70 - Bron Hebog - Rob Waller - 1:76 - OO9 - Welsh Highland Railway - Steam

Bron Hebog (009 / 4mm) shows the modern day Welsh Highland Railway at Beddgelert. As well as the station and passing loop - built to accommodate an authentic 10 carriage train - this large scenic layout shows the long climb up the steep S-bend to the north, and the line passing through the rocky Goat Tunnel on its way into the Aberglaslyn Pass.

The Garratts were made from the Backwoods Miniatures brass kits - we have five of them running on the layout - and most of the rolling stock is scratch built.

We also run a full range of Ffestiniog Railway locomotives and trains which may occasional appearances on the connected Welsh Highland line.
